CLARIFICATIONS TO THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL:

BID DATE: Remains the same – September 25th, 2024 at 2pm.

SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION DATE: Date for work remains the same: August 23rd, 2025

Question #1: Please clarify if a compressible tube expansion joint is acceptable at detail 5/A501 to match detail 4/A501.

Answer: No. One detail is for an expansion joint with new membrane roof systems on each side. The other details is where on side of the expansion joint is an existing roof membrane system to remain and the other side is the new roof membrane system. Based on the design information available from various manufactures of roof membrane systems these are two different conditions that require different details.

Question #2:

Spec section 00204 10.2 A 4 calls to maintain CGL coverage for itself and the city of keene for at least 7 years after complete of this work. Just confirming this spec does not apply to this project.

Answer: This is true. Does not apply
